Background

So far this year he has gone on photography trips to the Galapagos Islands, Florida, and Hawaii. These trips resulted in many fine photographs in both the digital format and on B&W film. He is currently creating prints of these photographs for the "Art Around Town" program in Morgan Hill. This program provides an opportunity for artists to display their work at local businesses.

Steve Soult prefers to produce B&W silver gelatin prints using the traditional darkroom process. These prints are processed to archival standards and selenium toned in accordance with the process originally used by Ansel Adams. A selection of his B&W silver gelatin prints is currently on display at the Morgan Hill Art Gallery.
